How to Submit

Categories

First, choose to enter your project in one category at your scholastic level:

High School / Secondary School / Community College Level

**Design a Concert Hall using MicroStation® or
MicroStation PowerDraft®**

Projects in this category should:

- » Enhance the performing arts
- » Portray a facility you would love to attend

Community College/ University / Collegiate Level Innovation in Architectural Design

Projects in this category should:

- » Demonstrate excellence in planning, designing, building, modeling, analyzing, operating and maintaining one or more buildings

Innovation in Engineering Design

Projects in this category should:

- » Exhibit excellence in the engineering of roads, bridges, rail, water, and mapping

Innovation in Structural Engineering

Projects in this category should:

- » Demonstrate excellence in planning, modeling, analyzing, designing, documenting, detailing, or delivering one or more structures

Communicating through Visualization

Projects in this category:

- » Employ visualization capabilities to enhance the quality and/or productivity of the delivered project
- » Utilize Bentley technology to model, visualize, and/or animate infrastructure design
- » Demonstrate excellent use of materials, lighting, texture, view composition, or analysis/simulation



Submission Process

1. Read the rules and requirements document, which will outline all required materials for your nomination, and ensure you are eligible for the competition.
2. Review the submission tutorial, which will allow you to preview the submission form and help you prepare the proper submission materials.
3. Submit your project online by completing the easy four-step submission form.
4. Send or upload your supporting image files and PowerPoint presentation
